President's Remarks

The Sacred Heart Foundation hit an important milestone in 2022. For the first time in our history, the Foundation was able to contribute \$100,000 to the Missionaries of the Sacred Heart. My fellow board members and I are proud of that number and understand it represents 55 years of hard work. Of course, you may know pride as one of the seven deadly sins. Before our heads get a little too

big, it's important we remind ourselves that we received scholarship requests from the various MSC Provinces in the amount of \$248,108. Inflation isn't just a local problem. MSC communities around the world are dealing with it as well. When Fr. Aubin established the Foundation in 1967 with the help of local community leaders, a loaf of bread cost 22 cents. A gallon of gasoline cost 33 cents. A postage stamp cost 5 cents. I could list the price for those items today but by the time you receive this newsletter, there is a very good chance that number will have climbed even higher. In short, we are providing more scholarship dollars than ever before. Unfortunately, the need for those scholarships is greater than ever before as well. That's why your support is so important. Your generosity today will ensure the Foundation is able to continue its efforts well into the future. With your help, the Sacred Heart Foundation will continue to support seminarians long enough so that 55 years from now, the board President in 2077 can remind foundation members how cheap it was to live back in 2022. As always, thank you for all of your past generosity. We hope you enjoy the rest of your summer.

Planned Giving

Are you turning 72 this year? Has your financial institution told you that you have to take a required minimum distribution from your IRA? Are you thinking to yourself, "I don't really need that money"? If so, it may make sense to call your financial advisor and ask her to set up a charitable distribution directly from your IRA.

Individuals over age 72 can donate up to \$100,000 from an IRA directly to a qualified charity without triggering any federal income taxes. Under the qualified charitable distributions provision, you request a distribution from your IRA and provide your financial advisor with the name and address of the qualifying charity. The distribution can be sent directly to the charity of your choice...like the Sacred Heart Foundation!

There are a number of potential tax benefits to you for making a charitable contribution directly from your IRA. (1) Income tax on the distribution is avoided, even if you do not itemize deductions and even if your gifts exceed the percentage of income limits for charitable deductions. (2) The distribution does not increase your adjusted gross income for purposes of reducing itemized deductions, nor does it limit the amount of deductible medical expenses or miscellaneous itemized deductions or increase the taxation of your Social Security benefits. (3) If the state you live in determines taxable income based on federal adjusted gross income, there is no state income tax on the distribution, even if the state does not allow the charitable deduction

Maybe now is the time to speak to your financial advisor or tax professional to see if a donation directly from your IRA to the Sacred Heart Foundation, makes sense for you.

Fr. Corneille Boyeye, MSC is from the Democratic Republic of the Congo in Africa. Fr. Corneille was ordained a priest in August of 2002. In October of 2014, he immigrated to the U.S. and has been here ever since. While in Africa, he served as Pastor of Sainte Marie Madeleine Parish in Kinshasa. From there, he became treasurer of the Union of the Missionaries of the Sacred Heart in Africa and an educator at the MSC Scholasticate in Cameroon. In 2011, he was regional leader of the Missionaries of

the Sacred Heart in the Congo, simultaneously serving as president of the Association of the Major Superiors in the Ecclesiastic Province of Mbandaka. He served in these positions till his relocation to the U.S. In 2015, Fr. Corneille was enrolled in the Hesburgh Sabbatical Program at the Catholic Theological Union in Chicago; while there, he enrolled in some English courses. From 2016-2019, he served as priest chaplain at Saint Catherine of Siena Medical Center in Smithtown, NY. During this time, Fr. Corneille had the opportunity to serve on the Clinical Pastoral Education studies for Board Certification as Chaplain with the National Association of Catholic Chaplains. In 2020, Fr. 
